<p><b>“Controlled Load”</b> These tariffs are generally only available where the hot water system or other appliance is separately metered and can be time-controlled to operate at low-demand times. Off-peak tariffs are sometimes called ‘controlled load’, and will always operate with some other tariff type in place for the other times of the day (for example single rate tariffs or time of use tariffs)</p> <p><b>“Daily Supply Charge”</b> is a charge that applies for supplying electricity to your premises for each day of the billing period, regardless of your consumption.</p>
<p><b>“kWh”</b> stands for kilowatt hour and is the unit of measurement for your electricity bill.</p>
